SPIRITUAL SHIFT 1: FROM REACHING TO MAKING

It's not enough to reach people if we are not making biblical disciples.

- John 14:15
- Matthew 7:24
- 2 Cor 13:5



SPIRITUAL SHIFT 2: FROM TEACHING TO MODELLING

We must intentionally model what it looks like to follow Jesus and lead others to do the same.

- 1 Cor 11:1
- 1 Tim 4:12



SPIRITUAL SHIFT 3: FROM ATTENDING TO PARTICIPATING

Discipleship cannot simply be a program or a ministry we offer it is dependent on participating in the endless process of following Christ.

- Eph 4:16
- Heb 10:24-25



SPIRITUAL SHIFT 4: FROM CONNECTING TO TRANSFORMING

To cultivate the kind of disciples Jesus did, we have to shift our thinking from activity and surface connections to deep, accountable relationships.

- Eccles 4:9-12
- 1 Cor 12:26
- Galatians 6:1-2
- James 5:16



SPIRITUAL SHIFT 5: FROM ATTRACTING TO DEPLOYING

Shifting our scorecard from how many people we gather to how many disciples we deploy is essential.

John 20:21 (NLT) Again he said, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I am sending you...."



THE LOVE OF THE FATHER SENDS US

 The most frequent verb associated with the Father in the Gospel of John is 'send'.

 17 times we are informed that the Father has 'sent' the Son (apostellein):

3:17,34 / 5:36,38 / 6:29,57 / 7:29 / 8:42 / 10:36 / 11:42 / 17:3, 8, 18, 21, 23, 25 / 20:21



THE LOVE OF THE FATHER SENDS US

 The most frequent verb associated with the Father in the Gospel of John is 'send'.

 7 occasions we come across perhaps the pre-eminent title for God in the fourth gospel: "the Father who sent me" (ho pempsas me pater)

5:23, 37 / 6:44 / 8:16, 18 / 12:49 / 14:24,



THE LOVE OF THE FATHER SENDS US

- The most frequent verb associated with the Father in the Gospel of John is 'send'.
- 16 we come across the simpler expression: "he who sent me" (ho pempsas me)
- 4:34 / 5:24, 30 / 6:38f (x 2) / 7:16, 28, 33 / 8:26,29 / 9:4 / 12:44(x2) / 13:20 / 15:21 / 16:5



PROBLEM:

"Christians tend to be incredibly selfindulgent. They see the church as a place there for them to meet their needs and to express faith in a way that is meaningful for them. There is almost no genuine compassion or urgency about serving and reaching lost people"
